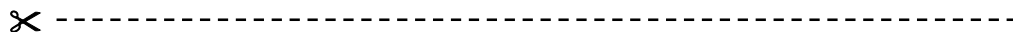

Answers:

Easy – C 25 10 metres in 2 hours means 5 metres in one hour; so in 5 hours the snail would travel 25 metres. By ratios, the distance travelled is $10 \times (5 \div 2) = 25$,

Hard – C 25 2005 = 5 x 401 so 5 is a factor but 25 is not.
