Easy – D 5 years

Hard – C $2 \frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} = 1$ and $\frac{1}{2} \div \frac{1}{2} = 1$ but $\frac{1}{2} - \frac{1}{2} = 0$ and $\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2} = \frac{1}{4}$

Puzzling – C 2003 2002 and 2004 are divisible by 2. 2001 and 2004 are divisible by 3. 2005 are divisible by 5. That leaves 2003 which is not divisible by any number except one and itself, which makes it a prime number.
