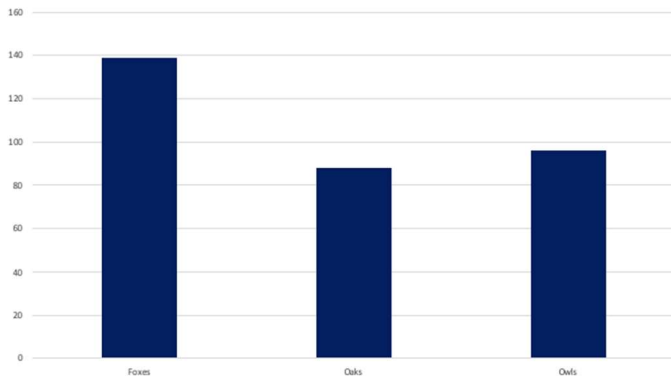
- Anticipating the start of clubs

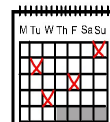
