I am impressed by the daily practice that children have completed. Six weeks ago pupils did not know how to hold a violin. Now pupils can hold their violin and bow correctly and they are developing the strength in their fingers which they will need to play notes.

Daily practise teaches your child that things that they find difficult are achievable *if they work hard*. This is a lesson we try to teach throughout the school. Are you encouraging your child to do their daily homework?

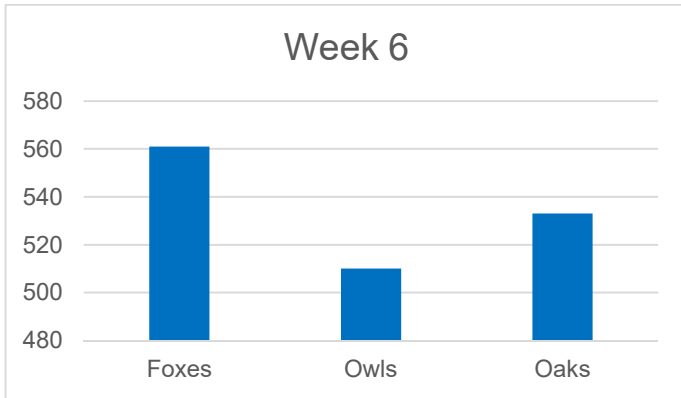

Well done to the Foxes who won with a 51 point margin. The Oaks have 510 points and the Owls have 533.

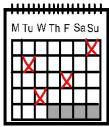
