Sylvia thought of her aunt's strict rules: never eat in front of strangers, tip all the servants immediately and do not cry in front of Bonnie.

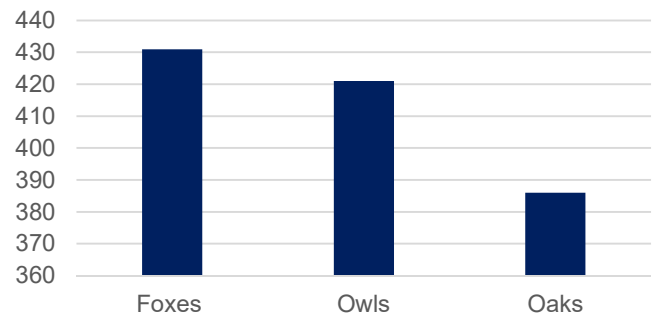


House Points

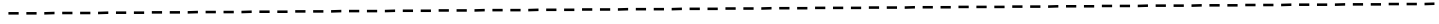
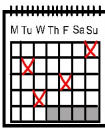
